

# COMMUNITY CARE COMMON STANDARDS WORKSHOP



The Community Care Common Standards (CCCS) have been developed jointly by the Australian Government and State and Territory Governments as part of broader community care reforms to develop common arrangements that help to simplify and streamline the way community care is delivered. (Department of Health & Ageing - 21 January 2011)

The CCCS will replace the National HACC Standards and will be introduced across Australia in March 2011. All HACC service providers are expected to work towards complying with the Common Standards from 1 March 2011.

The NSW Government has engaged Aged and Community Services (ACS) to support the HACC sector in preparing for the adoption of the new CCCS. This support will take many forms and includes small workshops and working individually with providers where necessary.

The first round of workshops is scheduled to begin in March and continue through till June 2011 and ACS will facilitate at least one workshop per Local Planning Area (LPA).

The workshops are designed to be practical and interactive and will give participants the opportunity to work through the CCCS and the self- assessment. To ensure quality interaction the numbers for each workshop will be limited to one place per organisation.

Participants are expected to bring along any information that may assist them in the workshop including: CCCS Guide, or at least be familiar with the standards; knowledge of their organisational policies and procedures; and be aware of processes of compliance with HACC standards, Funding Agreement and MDS. Where possible, it is suggested that participants bring a list of current policies to assist in identifying challenges and gaps.
