



MEDICAL EQUIPMENT that may needs to be moved with you has also be recorded as follows.....

**IMPORTANT** For the register to be effective we must ensure that only those clients who have no way of leaving their homes unassisted are entered on the register. If you become able to self evacuate or someone moves in to your home that can assist you to evacuate please ensure that you notify the service to take your name off the register.

Privacy of your Information

The Police are governed by Privacy Legislation and will only release client information to other emergency service's as they deem necessary. The Police Computer Intranet can only be accessed by authorised personnel with a current password after acknowledging the following displayed caveat:

"You are forbidden to communicate this information to anyone outside the NSW Police unless you have authority to do so. Personal information, as defined in the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998, is only to be used in accordance with the Act and NOT for an administrative or educational purpose"

**What to do if you move or other information changes**

It is vital for you to advise .....(service doing assessment) on .....(phone number) should any of your details change, such as a change of address or you become able to self evacuate. Valuable time may be wasted in a critical situation if police are trying to access a home only to find the resident has moved some months ago. The service will pass the changes onto the police. DO NOT contact the Police yourself regarding the register.

Please keep this information sheet as your record of being registered on the Emergency At Risk Register.
